SSM Motorcycle Training Courses

Riding a motorcycle requires a whole new set of safety skills to avoid a mishap or collision. Whether you're a seasoned rider or just learning, SSM's motorcycle training courses provide valuable information to help you stay safe.

21 Hour Course

- ▲ If you are a new rider, or just wanting to build confidence, this is the course for you. We cover all the basics of safe motorcycle riding, and take you from the assumption of never driving a motorcycle, to the dynamics of collision avoidance and emergency braking.

8 Hour Course

- ▲ This is an 8 hour session intended for new and inexperienced motorcycle riders, although not as comprehensive as our 21 hour program. Previous motorcycle experience is not required for this course, but it can be very helpful.

Our courses are developed by motorcyclists for motorcyclists. Whether you are a beginner or experienced rider, ride for transportation or ride for recreation, our courses will help you develop:

- ▲ Safe riding strategies
- ▲ Defensive riding skills
- ▲ Emergency techniques

Our instructors are experienced riders and qualified motorcycle safety trainers.

SSM's motorcycle training courses are recognized by MPI and qualify you for your Class 6 (Motorcycle) licence. **A Valid 6M motorcycle license is required prior to registering for either the 21 hour or 8 hour course.**

21 Hour Motorcycle Training: \$350

Want to learn to ride a motorcycle and build your confidence on the road? SSM's 21 Hour Motorcycle Training course covers all the basics of motorcycle safety and riding. The course includes four hours in class and 17 hours of practice on a motorcycle. Previous riding experience is not required.

This training covers:

- ▲ Motorcycle Dynamics
- ▲ Braking techniques
- ▲ Collision avoidance
- ▲ Gear shifting and signals
- ▲ Slow Speed Control
- ▲ Safety checks

MPI provides a rebate of \$162.50 of your registration fee when you successfully complete the final skill test.

8 Hour Motorcycle Training: \$275

Want to review and update your riding skills to ensure your safety and increase your confidence on the road? SSM's 8 Hour Motorcycle Training course focuses on building practical skills with hands-on training.

The eight hour training course is offered in centres across Manitoba. The eight hour course fulfils the requirement for obtaining a Class 6 (Motorcycle) licence.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is the course still offered if it is raining or cold?

Yes. Rain or shine, you will learn how to ride a motorcycle!

Do you provide the motorcycle?

Yes. SSM provides a top-of-the-line fleet of motorcycles for students to train and practice their skills.

Do I need a licence to take this course?

Yes. You must obtain a Class 6 M (Training) licence from MPI to take the course.

Do I need to bring riding gear?

Yes. All students must provide their own riding gear, including:

- ▲ A sturdy jacket and pants (jeans and a leather or denim jacket)
- ▲ Eye protection
- ▲ Sturdy boots that cover the ankle
- ▲ Leather gloves
- ▲ DOT or Snell approved helmet

Your riding gear must be inspected and approved by the instructor at the first session.

I'm under 18. Do I need a parent to accompany me?

Only to the first session. If you are under 18, your parent or guardian must sign a waiver for you to participate in the training course.

Can I pay with a personal cheque?

Unfortunately, SSM does not accept personal cheques. We happily accept certified cheques, money orders, cash and credit cards.

Can I cancel my registration?

Yes, but you must pay a cancellation fee. Our motorcycle courses are very popular, and we often have a waiting list. Cancellations and transfers are available only in case of emergency.
