

Want to turn your OH&S experience into a professional designation?

The HSP Designation Certificate Program includes:

- 30 credits of mandatory and elective SSM courses (one credit equals eight hours of training);
- A practical project; and,
- A final exam.



To be eligible for the program you must:

- Presently hold a position or be working toward a career in OH&S;
- Be a member of Safety Services Manitoba;
- Continue to be involved in health and safety at your workplace after you complete the program; and,
- Be committed to ongoing professional development in the field of OH&S.

Quick Facts:

- Even participants working full-time can likely complete 30 credits within 2 years
- With approval and appropriate documentation, you can transfer up to 6 credits from other institutions to the HSP Designation Certificate
