Did you know that every piece of industrial equipment in Manitoba must be in compliance with CSA Standard Z432-04 Safeguarding of Machinery? Manitoba Workplace Safety & Health is issuing improvement orders for machine guarding, but do you know how to properly guard your equipment to get those work orders lifted, or to fix the concerns before it's too late? We will walk you through our structured process of how to assess your machines and determine the ideal safeguard to protect your operators. We'll talk about solutions that are safe but also take your process in mind to work with your operation. We will explain a predictive process to identify issues, before you fall into a reactive mode with an improvement order.
